RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby appropriates in Fiscal Year 2019/2020 amounts of \$32,000 Measure B-VLF (Fund #238) to fund the construction of the two phases of the 2018/2019 Traffic Signals at 40th Street – Harlan Street and Powell Street – Doyle Street, (CIP No. 03444125) and (CIP No. 16475001); and, be it further

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorize the City Manager to enter into a First Amendment Maintenance Contract with Ray's Electric in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, in the amount of \$32,000.00 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$751,500.00.
