SUBJECT: **Report To The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Of Actions Taken By The Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee For Council Consideration**

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend that City Council receive this report from the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC).

BACKGROUND

The BPAC consists of nine members of the Emeryville community; it meets ten times a year to provide input and recommendations to improve access, infrastructure, and safety for people who ride a bike or walk in Emeryville. The BPAC recommends actions for Council consideration. Members of the Committee requested a method of formally transmitting these recommendations to Council on a regular basis.

DISCUSSION

This first report of BPAC actions covers motions made to date in 2020. Future reports will be made on a quarterly basis or at another interval recommended by Council.

FISCAL IMPACT

While there are costs associated with the actions recommended by the BPAC, there is no fiscal impact to reporting the actions to Council.
