SUBJECT: Community Advisory Committee Appointments FY2020-21

RECOMMENDATION

Appointments to Community Advisory Committees are made at the City Council's discretion. A separate Resolution will be approved for each set of Committee appointments.

BACKGROUND

Each fiscal year, the City Council appoints community members to serve on the City's various Community Advisory Committees ("Committees"). Committees are an opportunity for community members to have input on specific programs and initiatives of the City. All Committee meetings are publicly noticed, and the public is encouraged to attend. Actions taken by Committees are forwarded to the full City Council for consideration and final action, with the exception that the Planning Commission and Housing Advisory and Appeals Board have some independent authority, with some decisions subject to City Council review or appeal.

The Committees consist of a wide range of community members representing specific demographics. Below are definitions of the various existing committee positions. It is not uncommon to receive an application from a candidate that fulfills the qualifications for multiple committee positions.

Business Representative	Person representing a business in Emeryville of any size.
City Labor Representative	Person representing a labor union with members represented in Emeryville.
Community Member	Person residing or working in Emeryville.
Large Business Representative	Person representing a business in Emeryville with over 56 employees.
Non-Profit Workforce Development Organization Representative	Person representing a local non-profit workforce development organization.
Resident	Person residing in Emeryville.
Resident (94608)	Person residing within the Emeryville-Oakland 94608 zip code.
Small Business Representative	Person representing a business in Emeryville with 55 or less employees.

DISCUSSION

There are several current vacancies on several of the Committees, and upcoming vacancies on all of the Committees due to terms which are scheduled to expire as of June 30, 2020. Notice of the vacancies was posted on the City's three bulletin boards. In addition, the City Clerk's Office included noticing of the vacancies on the City's website, Twitter and ETV Cable Channel 27, and made announcements at City Council meetings. City Clerk staff contacted previous applicants, as well as incumbents, to determine whether they had continued interest in serving on the Committees. Applications were due May 25, 2020, but a grace period was allowed until May 30, 2020, due to the Memorial Day holiday, as well as extenuating circumstances from the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting Shelter in Place Order.

The City Clerk's Office received several applications for the various vacancies from both incumbents and interested community members. Staff has also encouraged applicants to attend the virtual June 16, 2020, special City Council meeting where they will be able to introduce themselves and answer any questions the City Council might have. Sign in information for the meeting will be provided to all applicants.

In the event that there are positions not filled at the June 16, 2020, special City Council meeting, staff recommends re-advertising the remaining vacancies to be appointed at a future City Council meeting.

Bicycle / Pedestrian Advisory Committee

The Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee consists of up to nine (9) total members. The Committee's purpose is to provide input and recommendations regarding City policies, priorities and feedback related to the City's Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan and related initiatives.

The Committee has a current vacancy for one (1) Business Representative, and upcoming vacancies for four (4) Community Members. Committee member terms are for two years. The following applications have been received:

Budget Advisory Committee

The Budget Advisory Committee consists of up to five (5) total members. The Committee's purpose is to provide input and recommendations regarding City policies, priorities and feedback related to the City's budget.

The Committee has a current vacancy for one (1) Business Representative, and upcoming vacancies for one (1) Business Representative and two (2) Residents. Committee member terms are for two years. Some applicants qualify for either Committee designation; they are listed below in both categories for consideration. The following applications have been received:

Public Art Committee

The Public Art Committee consists of up to nine (9) total members. The Committee's purpose is to provide input and recommendations regarding City policies, priorities, and feedback related to the City's Percent for Art Ordinance, and related matters. Pursuant to Emeryville Municipal Code Section 2-3.403, the "Public Art Committee membership shall be determined by resolution of the City Council". In addition, pursuant to Emeryville Municipal Code Section 2-3.404, "the terms of the Public Art Committee shall be staggered and for a period of two years, commencing July 1 of the year of appointment; except that the City Council shall appoint two of the initial members to the expanded nine-member Committee to three-year terms".

The Committee has a current vacancy for either a Business Representative or Resident that is a designated three-year term, and upcoming vacancies for four (4) Business Representatives or Residents. Some applicants qualify for either Committee designation; they are listed below in both categories for consideration. The following applications have been received:
