The challenges of the current recession and the strains it puts on nation, state, and our city deeply concern me. Chairing my university's first Strategic Planning Council, serving as a leader in academic governance, managing an academic department, and my role as acting director of the University Library in a year of severe budget cut- backs has given me experience in dealing with institutional crises. I hope I can share some of this lore with those working presently to keep Emeryville both afloat and thriving.
