Resolution of the City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing the City Manager to Accept A Grant Award on Behalf of the Police Department, From the Federal DOJ, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$32,903 For Funds Related to Responding to the Corona Virus Pandemic Within the City And That The Funds Be Deposited And Appropriated into Grant Fund 254

WHEREAS, the Emeryville Police Department applied for and was awarded grant funding from the Federal DOJ, Bureau of Justice Assistance to assist in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the importance of maintaining and in some cases expanding police services during the pandemic is essential for maintaining public safety and the continuity of government services; and

WHEREAS, the police staffing went to an emergency schedule in response to the pandemic and the funding available will be used to cover police overtime costs, for safety equipment and for decontamination of police equipment;

WHEREAS, the Police Department will utilize the grant funding to educate the public and if necessary enforce Shelter In Place orders; to ensure police services are maintained throughout the pandemic; and to keep crime reduction low and police services high during the pandemic, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville approves the Police Department accepting the grant funding award by the Bureau of Justice Assistance, for monies in the amount of \$32,903; and that the funds be deposited into Grant Fund 254 and appropriated to spend in the same fund, and, be it, further
