

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-98****RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING APPROVING A PARKING PROCESSING AGENCY PROCEDURE MANUAL AS REQUIRED BY CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE SECTION 40200.6**

**WHEREAS**, on February 4, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 20-07, approving a contract with IPS to manage the City's parking citation process (IPS Contract); and

**WHEREAS**, Vehicle Code section 40200.6(b) specifies that the legislative body must establish written procedures pursuant to which the contracting party shall provide services; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the responsibilities and standards set forth in the IPS Contract, the Emeryville Police Department recommends that City Council approve the attached Parking Processing Agency Procedure Manual as required by Vehicle Code section 40200.6(b); and be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville approves Parking Processing Agency Procedure Manual attached hereto as Exhibit A as required per California Vehicle Code section 40200.6(b).
