Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Execute A Community Grants Recipient Contract With Emeryville Citizens Assistance Program In The Amount of \$75,232 To Support Food And Clothing Distribution To Persons Experiencing Homelessness And Those Near-Homelessness For Fiscal Year 2020-2021

**WHEREAS**, the Emeryville Citizens Assistance Program (ECAP) provides support for atrisk families and individuals by providing a daily food give-away, clothing, counseling services, and resource referrals for housing and personal needs in Emeryville; and

**WHEREAS,** ECAP is requesting a total of \$75,232 in support for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 to cover costs of the program's rent, utilities, and operating expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, ECAP's tax-exempt status had been suspended by the California Secretary of State and Franchise Tax Board in April of 2019 because of ECAP's failure to timely file a required submittal, causing a delay in disbursement of Fiscal Year 2019-2020 funds to ECAP; and

**WHEREAS,** ECAP has since worked to gain reinstatement of its tax-exempt status and, as of July 10, 2020, has now revived its non-profit status to good standing; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Community Grants Recipient Contract with ECAP for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 includes performance milestones intended to ensure that ECAP works towards increasing its administrative capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, ECAP provides an important community service for individuals and families in need; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** that the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorizes the City Manager to execute a Community Grants Recipient Contract for FY 2020-2021 with Emeryville Citizens Assistance Program in substantial form as attached to this resolution as Exhibit A for an amount not to exceed \$75,232; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute minor amendments to the Community Grants Recipient Contract, provided such amendments do not increase the City's obligations thereunder.
