SUBJECT: Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Appointing

City Council Members To Serve As City Council Member Liaisons To The City's Community Advisory Committees For Calendar Year 2021; And Amending The FY2020-21 Local Roster Of Boards, Commissions

And Committees Accordingly

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the above-entitled Resolution appointing Council Members as liaisons to the City's Community Advisory Committees for calendar year 2021.

BACKGROUND

On April 18, 2017, the City Council approved Resolution No. 17-54 which reinstated the practice of assigning a non-voting Council Member to act as a liaison between the City Council and the City's Community Advisory Committees ("Committees"), with the exceptions of the Planning Commission and the Housing Advisory and Appeals Board – due to their distinct structures and purposes – and the Housing Committee and the Parks and Recreation Committee due to an initial lack of interest in having a Council Member liaison.

On October 2, 2018, the City Council expressed a desire to also appoint liaisons to the Housing Committee and the Parks and Recreation Committee. On December 10, 2018, the City Council approved Resolution No. 18-167, which appointed Council Member liaisons to all Committees, except the Planning Commission and the Housing Advisory and Appeals Board.
