Resolution of the City Council of the City of Emeryville Accepting A Donation of A Container of Emergency Supplies from Novartis

WHEREAS, Novartis is in need of disposing of a container filled with emergency supplies due to their vacating their current facility in Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, Novartis wishes to donate this container filled with emergency supplies including storage racks filled with pop up canopies, emergency first aid supplies, blankets, water, tools, caution tape, stretchers, body bags, tags, respirator/face shields, gloves, Tyvek suits, bullhorns, toilet paper, paper towels, lights sticks, chairs and a standing heat lamp to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City in its desire to be prepared for an emergency has a need for these emergency supplies; and

WHEREAS, the container, which is wired for electricity, can be utilized either to store the donated supplies, or it can be used as a permanent replacement for a container that the City is currently renting; the emergency supplies may be used in the City's Emergency Operations Center or out in the field during an emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the proposed donation to the City is valued at more than \$250, and must be accepted by the City Council by resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby accepts the donation of a container filled with emergency supplies valued at \$8,500 from Novartis and thanks Novartis for their generosity to the City.
