SUBJECT: **An Ordinance Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Temporarily Waiving Or Modifying Certain Provisions Of The Planning Regulations Related To Temporary Use Permits For COVID-Related Uses; CEQA Determination: Exempt Pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(4) and State CEQA Guidelines 15269(c) and 15061(b)(3)**

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the second reading of the above-referenced ordinance temporarily waiving certain provisions of the Planning Regulations related to Temporary Use Permits for COVID-Related Uses.

DISCUSSION

The City Council adopted the first reading of the attached ordinance on November 17, 2020 with no changes. The staff report for the November 17, 2020 City Council meeting, which provides a detailed explanation of the proposed ordinance, is attached for reference (see Attachment 1).
