Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Cancelling The Municipal Election To Be Held On November 3, 2020 Due To Only One Person Being Nominated For Each Of Three Council Seats To Be Elected, And No Ballot Measures Being Qualified For The Election, And Appointing The Nominated Individuals To The City Council Seats

WHEREAS, a municipal election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 3, 2020, to fill three at-large seats on the City Council of the City of Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, on the 88th day before the November 3, 2020 municipal election, only one person was nominated for each open City Council Member office with an expiring term that would be elected on a citywide basis at the election, and no ballot measures are qualified for the election; and

WHEREAS, Section 10229 of the California Elections Code authorizes the City Council to take one of the following courses of action: (1) appoint to office the person who has been nominated, or (2) hold the election; and

WHEREAS Section 10229 of the California Elections Code provides if, by the 75th day before the municipal election, no person has been appointed to office, the election shall be held; and

WHEREAS, by certificate attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, the City Clerk has certified to these facts; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk caused notice of these facts to be published pursuant to Section 6061 of the California Government Code and Section 10229 of the California Elections Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the recitals set forth above are true and correct; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the municipal election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, is hereby cancelled; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby appoints the following individuals for the offices to which they were nominated: (1) John J. Bauters for the office of City Council Member, (2) Ally Medina for the office of City Council Member and (3) Christian R. Patz for the office of City Council Member; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the persons herein appointed for each office shall qualify, take office, and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for such office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall certify to the passage, approval, and adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and the City Clerk's certification to be entered in the permanent records of the City.
