SUBJECT: **Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville to Rename 47th Street Between San Pablo Avenue and Doyle Street to Steve Dain Drive**

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the above-entitled resolution.

BACKGROUND

On May 19, 2020, City Council accepted a report from a Council ad hoc Committee concerning renaming 47th Street between San Pablo Avenue and Doyle Street to Steve Dain Drive and instructed staff to take action to complete the street renaming accordingly.

DISCUSSION

Staff has completed the research regarding impacted properties and utility services on 47th Street between San Pablo Avenue and Doyle Street and recommends the following action to complete the street renaming process:

- 1) Letters be sent officially noticing the properties and services located on 47th Street between San Pablo Avenue and Doyle Street of the street name change to take effect March 1, 2021.
- 2) Staff is proposing the segment of street be posted as both 47th Street and Steve Dain Drive for a two-year period to allow for ease of transition for wayfinding and changes the two addressees on the street will have to make.
- 3) Replacement of street signage at the intersection of 47th Street and San Pablo Avenue and the intersection of 47th Street and Doyle Street.

In addition to these actions, staff will notify the emergency services, utility companies, and Postmaster. The Postmaster will notice the change and continue to deliver mail addressed with the 47th street addresses for a minimum of 18 months.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funds are available in Public Works Operating budget to purchase street signs and perform the work required to execute this renaming effort.

STAFF COMMUNICATION WITH THE PUBLIC

Staff has made contact with the Emeryville Unified School District and AC Transit regarding the address change to their facilities on 47th Street.

CONCLUSION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt the above-referenced resolution.
