SUBJECT: Ordinance Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Amending

Chapter 13, "Dockless Shared Mobility Systems," to Title 4 Of The Emeryville Municipal Code To Establish Regulations And New Permits To Operate Dockless Shared Mobility Systems In The Public Right Of Way (CEQA Determination: Exempt Pursuant to State CEQA

Guidelines 15061(b)(3), 15378(a),(b)(3))

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that City Council adopt the second reading of the above-entitled ordinance amending Chapter 13, "Dockless Shared Mobility Systems," of Title 4 of the Emeryville Municipal Code. The proposed amendment addresses parking requirements and response times for issues and complaints related to dockless shared mobility systems.

DISCUSSION

The City Council considered this item, added additional amendments to section 4-13.04(b), and adopted the first reading of the attached ordinance on February 2, 2021. The amendments added by the Council during the meeting are shown in **bold double underline** text in the ordinance. The staff report for the February 2, 2021 City Council meeting, which provides a detailed explanation of the amendments to the Municipal Code, is attached for reference (see Attachment 1).
