Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Approving The Scope Of Work For And Authorizing The City Engineer To Advertise For Public Bids The Construction Of The Quiet Zone Safety Engineering Measures Project, (CIP No. 19475008); And Appropriating \$4,200,000 Of TCEP Grant Funds And \$1,800,000 Of ACTC Grant Funds To Quiet Zone Safety Engineering Measures Project, (CIP No. 19475008)

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program adopted by the City Council in June 2019 includes a project titled, 'Quiet Zone Safety Engineering Measures' (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020, the City Council City approved minor scope of work changes to the Project and approved the permanent street closure of 66th Street 130' east of Shellmound Street at the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Crossing effective as soon as July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2021, the City Council approved an amended budget moving funds from various City and ACTC funding sources into the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2021, the City received approval from the CTC for the Project's Construction Funding Allocation Request for \$4,200,000 of TCEP Funding; and

WHEREAS, On July 10, 2018, the City Council approved Resolution 18-104, finding the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to state CEQA Guideline 15301(c) and granting the City Manager signature authority for all agreements necessary to assure completion of the Quiet Zone Safety Engineering Measures Project; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2018, the City executed a funding agreement with ACTC for \$1,800,000 of Measure BB Funding for the local match requirements of the TCEP program; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Work for the Project ("Scope of Work") includes Supplemental Safety Measures to be installed at the following locations:

- Installation of Supplemental Safety Measures SSM's include four-quadrant gates, pedestrian gates, new track panels, fencing, lighting, sidewalks, and medians at the 65th and 67th Street at-grade railroad crossings.
- Installation of new signal houses and all required UPRR signaling equipment required to facilitate the new crossing improvements
- Closure of 66th Street St-grade railroad crossing and removal of RR equipment at the 66th Street crossing
- Traffic Signal at 67th Street / Shellmound Street
- Traffic Signal at 67th Street / Hollis Street; and

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to advertise said project for Public Bids once the City Engineer has approved the plans and specifications.
