Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Rejecting All Bids For The Purchase And Delivery Of A 22-26 Passenger Wheelchair Accessible Bus

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019, the City Council approved Resolution No. 19-133, authorizing the City Manager to enter into a grant agreement with Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) for the purchase of a new bus; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement with Alameda CTC called for the bus to be delivered to the City by December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2021, staff issued a request for bids for the purchase of a new bus; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received from Creative Bus Sales in response to the request for bids, which specified delivery of the bus would be after December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the delivery of new vehicles is being delayed by the nationwide chip shortage, and

WHEREAS, the City will seek an amendment to the Alameda CTC to grant agreement to extend the date by which delivery of the new bus must be made; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that it hereby rejects all bids for the purchase and delivery of a 22-26 passenger wheelchair accessible bus and authorizes the City Manager to enter into an amended agreement with ACTC to extend the time of the grant for the purchase of the bus.
