Assistant Planner Navarre Oaks gave the staff presentation and responded to Council questions.

Mahya Salehi, Baran Studio Architecture, summarized the concerns that they had addressed since becoming involved in the project.

1. Brian Donahue spoke regarding the zone of stability concept as articulated in the General Plan.

COUNCIL DISCUSSION

Council Member Martinez requested that the Conditions of Approval include language requiring an arborist to be on site during work.

Steve Batchelder, Arborist, to respond to questions, described the procedure that would be in place.

Vice Mayor Bauters stated that protecting just the root protection zone would not be sufficient; and requested that the arborist be present to protect all trees in the construction zone, not just the redwood. He also asked that fire blight resistant street trees be planted.

Council Member Medina inquired whether it was feasible to make one unit affordable and Council Member Patz raised the issue of the zone of stability for the neighborhood.
