Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Approving The Purchase Of Art Work For The City's Annual Purchase Award Program Entitled Stucked By Emeryville Artist Prabin Badhia With Funding Of Up To \$3,700 From The Public Art Fund (Fund 243) For The Purchase And Installation Of The Art Work And Acknowledging Aerial Landscapes By Judy Hart And Terrace Martin By Ronald Davis As First And Second Alternates, Respectively (Charles S. Bryant / Chadrick Smalley / Amber Evans)

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to purchase an art work for the City's Annual Purchase Award Program. The art work is entitled *Stucked* by Emeryville artist Prabin Badhia. The estimated cost to purchase and install the art work is \$3,700 including a purchase price of \$700 and up to \$3,000 for installation, which is available in the budget of the Public Art Fund (Fund 243) for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, previously approved by the City Council.
