

Legislation Text

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Planning Director's report on Planning Commission actions at the August 22, 2019 meeting:

- (a) <u>Marketplace Redevelopment Project, "Parcel C"</u>. Consideration of a modification to the conditions of approval of Final Development Plan FDP13-001, which was approved by the Planning Commission on May 28, 2015, to allow additional commercial uses. The existing permitted commercial use for the newly constructed 30,000 square foot building is a grocery store.*
- (b) <u>Temporary Emergency Family Shelter</u>. Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit, Design Review, and Exception to Standards application for a proposed temporary emergency shelter for families at the former City Recreation Center located at 4300 San Pablo Avenue.*
- (c) <u>58Fifty Shellmound Project</u>. A third study session to review a Conditional Use Permit and Design Review proposal to demolish an existing 61,000 square foot three-story office building at 5850 Shellmound Way and replace it with an eight-story building accommodating 244 rental residential units with about 10,000 square feet of ground floor commercial space.
